






Online Parent Teacher Meeting On 22/11/2021

Students were highly benefited and gained knowledge about coagulation, coagulation mechanism, inter particle bridging, flocculation and electro coagulation.






Industry Visits

that shone on brighter ways!


For the thorns on tracks left behind,


