In future as well we would continue planting and growing trees


Note Book Distribution

Glimpse over last year's club projects



Report- Solid waste management

Solid waste management is one of the major environmental issues these days, the condition becomes even worse when no proper system exists to take care of these wastes in villages. Shroff S R Rotary Institute of Technology (SRICT) with the support of Rotary Club of Ankleshwar and Bharuch Enviro Infrastructure Itd (BEIL) took initiative to manage the solid waste (kitchen waste specifically) at Jitali Village. The whole project is sponsored by Bharuch Enviro Infrastructure Ltd (BEIL) and coordinated by Ms. Pratibha Gautam with major objective to manage the kitchen waste generating in the "Village Jitali" in a sustainable way and to convert it into compost through bacterial decomposition.



One of the villager, Mr. Firoj Hasan Solanki from Navi Nagari area shared his experience and told "Earlier we had no idea or sense of source segregation but now, not only we are practicing it but also we are training our children to do so and also telling its benefits to our relatives in other villages so that they can also enjoy the atmosphere of a clean village". Another villager Ms. Ammar Goman from Tekri Faliyu also thankfully recognized the effort done by Rotary Club of Ankleshwar and mentioned "we feel so happy and proud that we are actively involved in "Swatch Bharat Mission" started by our Prime minister and Rotary club has helped us a lot in establishing this system of solid waste management in our village. When we see that

the waste which we produce is being converted into compost in a hygienic manner, it gives us a feel of responsible citizen".

The Talati of this village, explained the transformation of this village which he has witnessed in a span of one year, he told " In last 2-3 years, I have noticed a drastic increment in the aesthetic value of this village. I want to thank Rotary club of Ankleshwar for their effort to bring awareness about source segregation among people of this village, providing dustbins to individual house and

guiding them to process the kitchen waste into valuable compost which can now be used for gardening purpose"

Today, with the active involvement of all the villagers, all the kitchen waste of this village is being collected and processed in rich manure which is further used for vegetable farming by the villagers.
